The Vines

This wine comes from one of the southernmost parcels of the appellation, on the seafront, a north-east facing slope.

The Wine

Based exclusively on Mourvèdre, we produce this wine with a short maceration period of only one night. The idea is to keep the freshness and the fruit of the grape variety whilst it also being a wine of a beautiful complexity.

Advice & Tasting

The colour is garnet red, with faint pinkish tints. The nose is flattering with aromas of morello cherries and spices. It is a very fine wine but still keeps a nice density. The attack is fresh, the fruit and spice aromas linger on the palate.

To be enjoyed lightly chilled, to accompany red mullet fillets a la plancha with seasonal vegetables, or simply with a nice platter of charcuterie.
